

What about French Government's Actions

Since 2014

- Agro Ecologic Project for France
 - => a majority of French farms to be committed to agroecology by 2025
- « Organic Ambition » Program
 - => Target of 10% of agricultural land in organic farming by 2021 (5.7 %)
- Territorial Food Program
 - => Bring together local production and local consumption
 - >>>> Nearly SFS but organic is just a possibility
 - => Rather farmers oriented



National Conference on Food (launched in June 2017)

Why a National Conference Food?

Bring together all the actors of the value chain to:

- Accompany the transformation of production models in order to better meet consumer expectations and needs,
- Promote choices of consumption that favor healthy, safe and sustainable food.

National Conference on Food (half time) Speech by the French President (October the 11th)

Objectives and propositions about organic

- Improve food quality, with more organic or agroecological farming
- More labels, quality signs, short supply
- Reach 50 % of organic or local supply in canteens within 5 years
 - => actually a little suspicious because
 - many contradictory interests to manage
 - >>> What will be the conclusions?















Mouans-Sartoux's Territorial Agri-Food Project

Reaching out food sufficiency, respecting the health and environment

Mouans-Sartoux City

- Over 10,000 inhabitants in a very populated region (South eastern)
- Success in serving 100 % organic and local food for all of its municipal catering.
- Encourage the installation of new farms
- Increase awareness about the sustainable food issue

Reach 100% Organic in collective

catering

In the canteens:

- 3 schools, 1 kitchen/school 1.000 meals/day
- -100 % organic food, without additional costs
- -60 % local (from the region)
- –85 % of the vegetable come from the Municipal Farm
- –Public procurement rules
- -80 % food waste reduction



Towards Organic sustainable food in collective catering

- -Vegetable **proteins** / better quality meat
- -Nutritional and **balanced meals** (vegetables, mediteranean diet, whole grain/unrefined products, menus created monthly...)
- -Healthy cuisine: no industrial food,on-site cooking, raw products

Results: Survey on Sustainable Food

Change in food behaviours

- •85 % of the families said they have changed their way of eating (more local, organic, healthier diet)
- •13 % always eat organic (x2 since 2013)
- .63 % often eat organic
- •31 % go to a local producer every week
- •99 % satisfaction with the project



Creation of a Municipal Farm

- •Created in **2010**, due to a lack of local vegetable offer to supply the canteens
- Organic farming production certified by Ecocert

•24 tons of vegetables produced in 2016 (85 % of the

needs)

•6 hectares – close to the city center

•2 employees + green spaces

Local Main Objectives

- •Undertake the **Territorial Agri-Food Project** (PAT) of Mouans-Sartoux
- •Reach **food sufficiency** on the territory
- Develop sustainable food in order to combine
- environment and health preservation
- Increase awareness about
- the sustainable food issue



Mouans-Sartoux: a very dynamic City

- Creation of a Center for sustainable food education
- •Support towards farmers' settlement and creation of a processing unit at their disposal
- •Création of a University degree program "Management of Sustainable Food Projects for Territorial Collectivities" with the Université Côte d'Azur
- •Launch on January the 24th, 2018 a network of organic and sustainable European cities, in order to share their good practices and strategies




Luberon Regional Natural Park

Luberon Regional Natural Park

Aim: Implement a sustainable food project on its own territory.

The Park coordinates a **network of partners**(municipalities, agricultural structures,
cultural institutions, teachers, collective catering,
cultural associations, etc.)
